Part 4, Isaiah 6:1-8

1. Read the passage allowed. What stands out for you?
2. Using the five senses describe the experience that Isaiah undergoes in this vision. What does he see, hear, taste, touch and smell?
3. Would the unfolding impact of this vision be diminished if God simply spoke to Isaiah's heart and said "will you go?"
4. Who is the God revealed in this vision?
5. Isaiah was one of the court prophets to serve the royal throne (unlike some biblical prophets who were not like Amos). How might God be elevating Isaiah's understanding of his call?
6. Have you ever experienced a new vision of God's glory? Has that vision impacted your Christian life?
7. How is it that the prophet gets to a place of trust with God so as to answer "Here am I send me?"
8. Do we need such a vision in order to be impacted by the truth dramatically depicted in Isaiah 6? What other ways does Jesus open our hearts to his call?
9. Isaiah says yes to God and commits himself to service, in what ways are we also called say "yes" and serve?
